- 2. Upon information and belief, online marketplace operators must generally provide a valid e-mail address to customers for completing payment and/or managing their e-commerce stores. Moreover, it is necessary for online marketplace operators to provide a valid e-mail address so that their marketplaces may communicate with them regarding issues related to the purchase, transfer, and maintenance of the various accounts. Additionally, a valid email address is necessary

for online marketplace account operators for completing payment via third-party payment

platforms such as PayPal.

3. Upon information and belief, unlike an e-mail address, which is typically verified

addresses. An online marketplace operator can input any physical address and, as a result, such

addresses are often false and/or are not where the e-commerce store operator is located.
